## **2021 General Election Voting information**

Students will be able to vote in the SGA General Election starting on Monday, March 1st until 11:59 pm on Wednesday, March 4th. All students, regardless of college, will be able to vote for the "Top Four" University-wide officer positions (President, Executive Vice President, Academic Vice President, and Services Vice President). Students in the following colleges will also be able to vote for their college council officers: College of Arts and Sciences, College of Education, College of Business, School of Music, School of Nursing, School of Public Health, and Kent School of Social Work. Again, students will be able to vote from Mar. 1 – Mar. 4 with the ballot closing at 12:00 am on Mar. 4.
